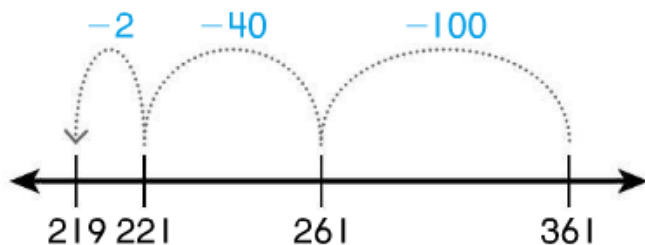
用心算来减

再看! Find $361 - 142$.

One Way

Start at 361 and count back 142.

Remember, 142 is
1 hundred, 4 tens, and 2 ones.



So, $361 - 142 = \underline{219}$.

Another Way

Use easier numbers.

140 is easier to subtract than 142.
 $142 = 140 + 2$

Subtract 140.

Then subtract 2 more.

$$\begin{array}{r} 361 \\ - 140 \\ \hline 221 \end{array} \quad \begin{array}{r} 221 \\ - 2 \\ \hline 219 \end{array}$$

So, $361 - 142 = \underline{219}$.

4. In September, Mrs. Anderson gives away 190 stickers.

$$989 - 190 = \underline{\quad\quad}$$

5. In October and November, Mrs. Anderson gives away 586 stickers.

$$\underline{\quad\quad} - \underline{\quad\quad} = \underline{\quad\quad}$$

 stickers

6. In December, Mrs. Anderson gives away 109 more stickers.

$$\underline{\quad\quad} - \underline{\quad\quad} = \underline{\quad\quad}$$

 stickers

7. **Higher Order Thinking** Kelly cuts out 265 strips of paper for an art project. She glues some strips of paper to her piece of art. Now she has 138 strips of paper left. How many strips of paper did Kelly use?

$$265 - \underline{\quad\quad} = 138$$
